



A registered microchip could mean the difference between lost and found

What is a microchip?

- It's not a GPS tracking device
- It's a rice-sized, radio-frequency identification device (RFID)
- It contains a unique number associated with your pet
- Once registered, it improves your pet's chances of getting home quickly if they ever go missing



How does a registry work?

- 1. Register your pet's microchip for free with the 24Petwatch registry and provide your phone number, email address, and information about your pet.
